940 Baldwin S.E. Congress School. Elementary school built in 1920 and completed in 1921, replacing a former 4-room building on the site. It was designed by Grand Rapids Public Schools staff architect Henry H. Turner. In 1970, houses to the west were demolished to create a park school, and Congress Avenue between Baldwin and Lake Drive was vacated. The building is architecturally distinctive, and retains a high level of integrity. The main alteration over the years has been the removal of the original windows. Capacity: 310. 2009-10 enrollment: 236.
