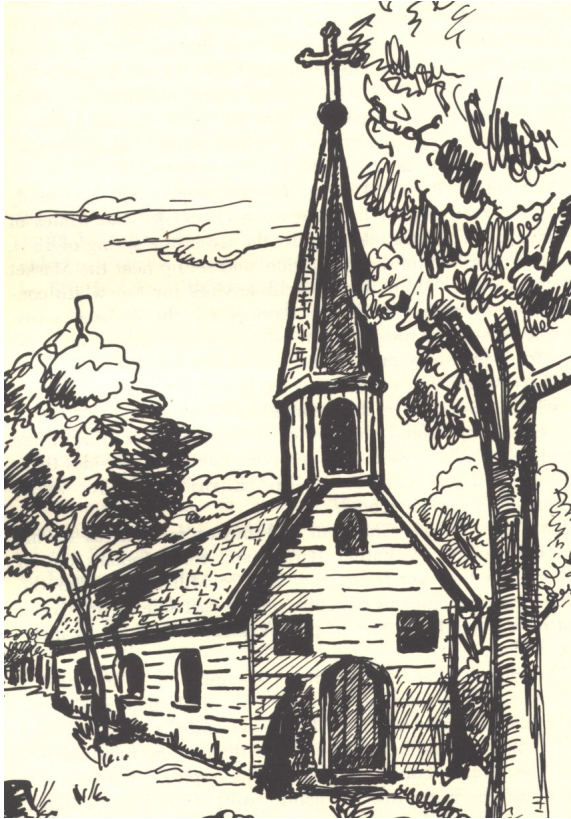


Butterworth Street, S.W.

525 Butterworth S.W. This is the approximate address of the Catholic chapel of St. Mary at the Grand River, dedicated by Fr. Frederic Baraga on April 20, 1834. The church was used until about 1847,



when Bp. Peter P. Lefevere of Detroit sold the land which had been given to the Catholic mission by the U.S. government for \$4,000. The building was moved in 1856 to First and Broadway, and with considerable renovation became the first St. Mary's Church for the new German parish. After it was replaced by the present St. Mary's Church in 1873, it was used as a hall, a school, and a home for the Sisters. In 1907, it was disassembled and rebuilt as St. Anthony's School at 1612 Hamilton N.W. That building closed in 1962 and was later demolished. (Sketch in Fr. John W. 706-08 Butterworth S.W. This cobblestone octagon house was built by Ira Jones in 1856. It was located on the south side of the street just west of Gold Avenue. Mr. Jones came to Grand Rapids in 1833. For a time, he was justice of the peace, and later held a city office. This home was built near what was then known as the Indian village, and Mr. Jones lived in it for over 40 years. In 1912 the residents were Mrs. A.E. Foster and Samuel P. Cox. The house had fallen into great disrepair by the time it was torn down in 1962. Old # 114.
