Flora Court, N.W.

This short roadway, which ran between Valley and Marcella Avenues and is now mostly covered by the I-196 expressway, was originally named Quigley Court, after the lumberman who built and lived in the great house at 1255. He owned a business in the south end, where Quigley Boulevard was also named after him. After his death, and perhaps to avoid the duplication in street names, this court was renamed Flora in honor of his widow.
