Fultonwood Drive, S.E.

This block-long cul-de-sac runs south off Fulton Street, E., just across from Marywood. It is one of the most striking areas of mid-century modern residential architecture in the city. Seven James Bronkema houses line the street, hugging the hills and creating a unified architectural development. Michael Pfleghaar and R. Lyle Boatman purchased a 1953 Bronkema house in mid-1993, and restored much of the altered original design, adding an Oriental influence to gardens that are an integral part of the living area.
