2530 Kalamazoo S.E. Woodlawn Cemetery. Known as perhaps the most beautiful cemetery in West Michigan, Woodlawn has 61 acres of land located in the southeast area of the city next to the Indian Trails Golf Course. The first portion of this cemetery was purchased in 1921 by the City of Grand Rapids. Woodlawn has a large number of family estates, single lots, lawn crypts, and columbarium niches available, and provides a special area for infant burial. The portion of the cemetery on the west side of Kalamazoo Avenue includes a chapel, and is formally recognized by the Diocese of Grand Rapids as a Catholic cemetery.
