

North Park Street, N.E.

North Park Bridge. The original steel truss bridge at this location was built in 1903. When it was replaced in 1989, one of the spans was floated downriver and set on stacked railroad ties in Riverside Park, but then neglected and forgotten. It was to have been placed connecting the park with an island-like area along the Grand River, but the City of Grand Rapids failed to make good on its earlier promises to rehabilitate the structure. This was finally accomplished about 1996-97.
