1901 Robinson Road, S.E. Historic Willowbrook has been part of Aquinas College since the 1960's--as a girls' residence hall, an office building, classrooms, and the College's Emeritus Center. Hospice also got its start at Willowbrook. In 1987, the house became a family residence once more, and in 1995 is home to College president R. Paul Nelson and his wife, Ruth.

2001 Robinson Road, S.E. This large estate and fine brick mansion was the property of grocery store magnate C. Thomas, who introduced the Kroger chain and supermarket shopping to the Grand Rapids area. The estate was purchased by the Diocese of Grand Rapids in 1968, and used for about 20 years as Christopher House, the residence for college seminarians.

2151 Robinson S.E. This large estate on the northeast corner of Robinson Road and Lakeside Drive, situated in Grand Rapids Township, was the home of Dudley Waters, Jr.
