518 Scribner N.W. Built as Engine House No. 3 in 1859 and replaced by the new engine house around the corner at Front and Second in 1887, this



ornate building housed the West Side Ladies Literary Club for many years. The club was founded in 1875 and once numbered 150 members. After this building was demolished for the US-131 expressway in 1961, the club moved to 154 Indiana N.W. Sena Edgerle was president for two terms from 1975-78. 849 Scribner N.W. This magnificent mansion was the residence of George Haney of the Haney School Furniture Company. He moved here in 1907-08,



and then moved to 501 Paris S.E. in 1916-17. From 1918 until its demolition for the US-131 freeway, it was the home of Dr. Frank A. Boet and his wife, Mabel. The Boets moved here from Comstock Park.
