The Milwaukee Bridge Co. finished the job after complying with War Department specifications. Total cost, \$59,000. The bridge bore the date of 1904. After sections of the deck gave way in 1949, the bridge was resurfaced and new structural plating installed in 1950 for \$50,000. The bridge was 400 feet long.
