17 Williams S.W. This 4-story brick building was constructed in 1917 as a warehouse. Until 2010, it was used for many years as a tire sales and warehouse building. After being transformed into 15 modern, affordable, energy-efficient, urban-style apartments by Midland-based Brookstone Capital, the building reopened in August, 2011, as Serrano Lofts. The renovation preserved heavy timber beams and other features.
